The discussion, with commentator and Musical America Editor Sedgwick Clark and GMSNY President Lewis Smoley, will focus on the various ways in which Bernstein changed the general perspective on Mahler’s music, and the special characteristics of his interpretations.

The evening will conclude with a Q&A session, and refreshments will be available.
